

Report on Visit to Anti-Drug Awareness Exhibition

On 23/06/2026, the Anti-Drug Committee of VCIWU organized an educational visit to the Anti-Drug Awareness Exhibition conducted by the Telangana Police's EAGLE (Elite Action Group for Drug Law Enforcement) Force at TGICCC, Banjara Hills, in connection with the International Day Against Drug Abuse and Illicit Trafficking observed on June 26.

A total of 55 undergraduate students from B.A., B.Sc., and B.Com programmes, along with 6 NCC cadets, participated in the visit and benefited from the awareness programme. The exhibition aimed to educate youth about the dangers of drug abuse and the importance of creating a drug-free society.
