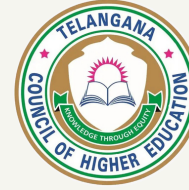

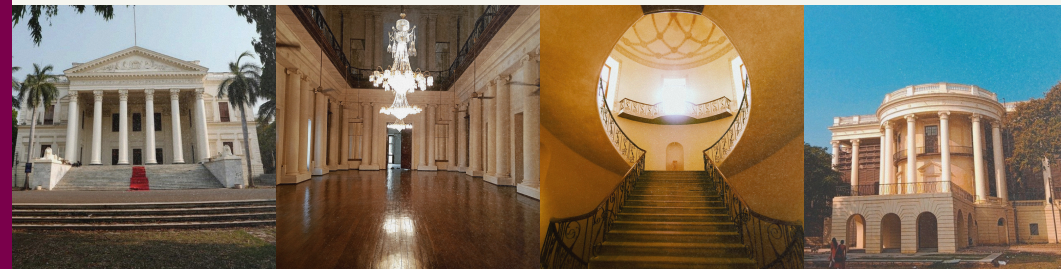

UNIVERSITY PROFILE

Veeranari Chakali Iamma Women's University is the first Women's University in the state of Telangana. It came into existence from 22-04-2022 through an act amendment passed in the Legislative Assembly and Legislative Council of the State of Telangana. It has been formed by upgrading University College for Women, a constituent and autonomous college of Osmania University established in 1924, the future torch bearer of Women's education and empowerment in Telangana.

The campus is located on the grounds of the former British Residency on the banks of Musi river on a sprawling 42 acres of land. The campus is home to a rich variety of heritage trees, flora and fauna. The University has achieved 2(f) status on 23/3/2025 thereby obtaining UGC recognition to grant degrees to students. The Hon'ble Chief minister of Telangana Sri. A. Revanth Reddy released the logo of the University on 4th April 2025

Veeranari Chakali Iamma Women's University offers 40 UG Courses and 24 PG Courses. It has 30 UG Departments and 21 PG department and 2 PG diploma courses. New courses like B.Sc (Data Science), Bachelor of Business Administration, B.Sc in Fashion design and Technology, B.Com (Business Analytics), B.Sc in Medical Lab Technician, M.Sc Food Science, M.Sc Data Science have been introduced since its inception in 2022.

Veeranari Chakali Iamma Women's University has excellent infrastructure, 250 teaching faculty and 300 non teaching staff.

OUTCOME BASED EDUCATION

Outcome based education (OBE) is a student-centric educational model that maps and measures student performance at every phase. The OBE model aims to maximize student learning outcomes by developing their knowledge and skills. The approach of OBE is to focus on the results of the learning process, rather than just the delivery of content. OBE process aims to produce students who are not only knowledgeable in their field of study but who are also able to apply that knowledge to real-world situations. This student-centred instruction model focuses on measuring student performance through outcomes that include knowledge, skills, attitudes and evaluation of outcomes of the program by stating the knowledge, skill, and behaviour. In the OBE model, the required knowledge and skill sets for a particular degree are predetermined and the students are evaluated for all the required parameters (Outcomes) during the course of the program. The outcome-based education system has proven to be a success in helping institutions measure their learning outcomes and at the same time enabling students to develop new skills that prepare them to stand out with their global counterparts.

ABOUT FDP

Outcome-Based Education (OBE) workshops primarily benefits the students, faculty members, educational administrators, and institutional leaders by providing frameworks to design curriculum, improve assessment techniques, and align teaching with measurable student outcomes. Students gain from enhanced learning experiences, while institutions boost their reputation and accreditation ratings. As is mandate of NAAC the every Higher Education Institution must organize workshops/seminars on OBE. IQAC, VCIWU is organizing 3 day OBE workshop in two phases. The first workshop will be held on 29-31st January, 2026 and the second workshop tentatively in the second week of February 2026. At the end of the workshop the faculty will be able to clearly define the programme and course outcomes which will enable students to achieve the essential outcomes. The program is one of the initiatives from IQAC towards creating awareness among faculty for NAAC Accreditation.
